UK BARISTA CHAMPIONSHIPS 2012 TRAINING AND INFORMATION DAY

Coffee XTC are holding a Barista Info Day on 16th November 2011.

Denise Hall – owner of Coffee XTC, a UKBC Sensory Judge, and SCAE Authorised Trainer will be opening the doors to her training centre near Stansted, to help baristas prepare for entering the UK Barista Championships in 2012.

The format for the day will be a practical session in the morning, then a quick run through of the rules, followed by baristas scoring each other, ending with a question and answer session.

There will be no charge for the day, but baristas must pre-book (see below for contact details).

Coffee XTC has a San Remo Verona TCS machine (similar to the San Remo Roma machines used at the UKBC) and also a San Remo grinder for use on the day. Baristas are welcome to bring their own coffee along, or use coffee supplied by Coffee XTC.

The machines will be set to the temperature used in the 2012 UKBC – 92°C.

There is plenty of free parking at the training centre, and if anyone takes the train from London Denise has offered pick them up from Newport Station (Essex).

The top scoring barista in the UKBC finals will be crowned UK Barista Champion 2012 and will go on to compete in the World Barista Championship in Vienna, Austria on 12th-15th June.
